

Flyin' Bob's Circus Skills Workshop

A one-day workshop where sessions are informal, fun, and hands-on. All equipment is provided.

For over 20 years, across Canada and in fifteen countries around the world, Flyin' Bob has performed as a juggler, tightwire walker, comic, and musician in Canada, the US, Europe, Japan, Singapore, Australia, Korea, Israel, and Egypt. He has toured extensively to both schools and outdoors festivals throughout Western Canada. He also directs, produces and teaches at Youth Circus Camps across the country.



A one-day circus skills workshop includes an introduction to:

- ◆ juggling
- ◆ feather-balancing
- ◆ plate spinning
- ◆ foot-balancing
- ◆ wire walking
- ◆ rola-bola

Each class participates in one hands-on workshop session of approximately 60 minutes, and an average day of 4 to 5 sessions could introduce circus skills to as many as 150 students.

Flyin' Bob can start or end the day with a 30-minute comedy circus performance.
